

Personal data processing policy per EU Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR)

We value your privacy but we must collect some information to handle your requests.

In line with GDPR 679/2016 (GDPR) Article 13, the data you provide in this form will be handled by t33 Srl to give feedback to your requests. The form is not designed for visitors under 14 years old, or anyone not of legal age where they live. If you do not meet these requirements, do not enter your personal data.

Your personal data will be processed per GDPR Article 5: lawfully, fairly and transparently for the data subject; for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not further processed in a way that is incompatible with those purposes; adequately, relevant and limited to what is necessary; accurately and, where necessary, updated; ensuring that data subjects can be identified for no longer than is necessary to handle your request; ensuring appropriate security, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction or damage, by using appropriate technical or organisational measures.

The data is provided with the free and voluntary consent of the individual concerned. Without consent it is impossible to send the data, so we cannot respond to your request.

t33 directly processes the data through members of our organisation, or through people outside the company to handle your request. Such persons will deal with your data in accordance with instructions from t33, as outsourcing manager or in charge of data processing. The complete list of these people can be requested directly from t33 Srl in Ancona (AN) via Calatafimi 1 (Italy), which is the Data controller. Your data will not be disseminated and will be kept only for the time strictly necessary to fulfil the purposes of your request, or unless you withdraw your consent before then.

You have the right to access, rectify, cancel, restrict, or object to processing of your personal data and can withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing. You may lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority for application of requirements in Articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR, addressing the request to the Data controller.
