

Personal data processing policy per EU Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR)

t33 Srl, as Data Controller, advises people sending their Curriculum Vitae of the personal data processing policy pursuant to Article 13 of the GDPR 679/2016.

Nature of the data

When sending or submitting your curriculum vitae, we will process the personal data needed for selection (including evaluation of your personal data, educational qualifications, professional experience, etc.). Providing such data is therefore necessary to fulfill your specific request for evaluation of your application. We invite you to not provide data regarding a health condition, racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious beliefs, sexual orientations or any other information belonging to special categories of personal data if they are not strictly necessary for the evaluation.

Purposes of the data processing and retention period

The data in your curriculum vitae will be included in our database and kept for the entire period needed for the evaluation. It will be deleted or destroyed if your profile is not specifically interesting for the selection. In any case, your data will be retained for no longer than 3 years from collection.

Legal basis for processing

The data provision is based on your free and optional consent.

Recipient or categories of individual concerned

We will not disseminate your data. It may be communicated for evaluation to people within our company. No transfer to any country outside Italy is planned.

Consequences of a refusal to provide personal data

Failure to disclose personal information necessary for the selection will make it impossible for us to fully evaluate your application.

Your consent to process personal data is a necessary condition for accepting your curriculum vitae; failing this, your curriculum vitae will not be evaluated and may not be kept.

Data subject's rights

You have the right to access, rectify, cancel, restrict, or object to processing of your personal data and may withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing. You may lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority per Articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR, addressing the request to the Data controller, t33 Srl whose registered office is in Ancona (AN), via Calatafimi 1, Italy.
